Regulations for conducting computer testing of applicants for recovery and transfer to the Federal State Budgetary Educational Institution of the Ministry of Health of the Russian Federation

1. Computer testing of persons applying for transfer/restoration is carried out in a computer classroom using special computer software through the services of the 1C: Corporate University learning management system.

2. In the audience there are: the attestation commission of the faculty; a specialist of the educational and methodological management who provides technical support to the test takers and/ or other persons and employees by the decision of the attestation commission.

3. The test taker is prohibited from carrying and using reference materials, written notes, communication means and other technical means. Upon detection of the listed means, the applicant for restoration / transfer is removed from the audience, which is recorded in the protocol of the attestation commission.

4. To pass the test, a temporary account is created for the applicant for transfer / resume and a login and password are provided to enter the electronic educational environment of the university.

5. 50 tests are submitted for online testing and 50 minutes are allocated. The variant of test tasks is formed automatically by random selection from the bank of test tasks used at the university for conducting current control and intermediate certification in disciplines approved by the dean of the faculty.

6. Each test task has one correct answer. It is necessary to perform test tasks sequentially, answering each question. The software does not provide for a return to a previously completed task to correct a previously entered answer.

7. In case of questions about the order of testing, problems with computer equipment, software, it is necessary to raise your hand, after which a specialist approaches the test subject to provide the necessary technical assistance.

8. After the specified time, access to the testing database is automatically terminated.

9. At the end of the test, the results of the evaluation event are displayed on the screen.

10. A test task is considered completed if the test subject correctly answered at least 51% of the test tasks.

11. Summary information on the results of testing for each test participant is generated automatically. The results are transmitted to the technical specialists of the attestation commission.
